Public Internet Service

Solution Overview

The Public Internet service is a Virtual Private Network (VPN) on the KPSN that provides internet access via a pair of commercial internet feeds provided by the KPSN Supplier. The service uses private IP address space and sits behind a geographically separate pair of KPSN Supplier managed firewalls.

Sites and organisations offering this internet connectivity option can do so either filtered or un-filtered. The filtered option uses a Lightspeed offering utilising captive portal.

This service is designed to be used by KPSN Partners wishing to provide access to the internet for visiting members of the public.
